At the foot of the snowy you will find the Callejón de Huaylas and the Conchucos area, where history and living culture come together day by day.

**Paron lagoon**  
34 km to the north of Caraz city. On foot of the mountains Artesonraju and Pirámide Garcilazo one of the most beautiful routes in the region.

**Llanganuco lagoon**  
They are two beautiful lagoon surrounded of queñual forests. There are boat rides and walkings trails.

**Purhuay Lagoon**  
7 Km from Huari, it is ideal to take boat rides or kayak, bird watching or walks for their dense forests surrounding.

**Chavin Archeological Monument**  
One of the main archaeological sites of country, dates from the 1st century BC, visit the Old Temple to observe the Lanzón Monolithic. It count with one interesting site museum of free income.

**Climate change route**  
The visit to the glacier Pastoturi is part of a circuit that includes the Patococho lagoon, Pachacoto ravine, gasified waters of Pumapampa, Raimondii puya, among other attractions.

**Recommendations for having an unforgettable experience in the Huascarán National Park:**

- ▶ Respect the instructions given by the Park Rangers; they are there to help you.
- ▶ Follow only the signposted routes and trails; this will protect the habit of the flora and fauna.
- ▶ Keep the trails clean and take care of the infrastructure and signs of the National Park.
- ▶ Do not disturb the animals when they are in the process of eating, nesting,
- ▶ All adventure tourism activities must be do with tour operators authorized by the Huascarán National Park.
